PANTANAL NATURE STATION VOLUNTEER WORK PROGRAM

The Pantanal Nature Station Volunteer Work Program, managed by the Boticário Group Foundation for Nature Protection, was created in accordance with Law no. 9608/1998, which governs volunteer work in Brazil.

GOAL

Provide an opportunity for any citizen to become a multiplier in environmental protection.

ACTIVITIES

The Volunteer will undertake the following activities:

VACANCIES AND DURATION

☑ Work hours: Monday to Friday – 4 hours per day

Visitation support

Maintaining visitation structures, assisting visitors, monitoring groups and schedules, applying profile and satisfaction surveys.

Environmental Education

Environmental awareness and understanding activities for groups and other visitors.
Developing educational contents, activities, and events.

Management and maintenance activities

Compiling data, filling spreadsheets, arranging materials and collections.

Waste management

Helping sort and properly dispose of waste.

TARGET AUDIENCE

Any person over 18 years old interested in contributing to nature preservation. Characteristics such as proactivity, good interpersonal skills, being a team player, and public speaking skills, are invaluable to perform a good volunteer service.

APPLICATIONS

Applicants must complete the application form (available for download) and send it to estacaopantanal@fundacaogrupoboticario.org.br with the subject "Pantanal Nature Station volunteer work application".

SELECTION

Selection criteria are based on the application form, as well as an in-person or Skype interview. Selection results will be published on the Boticário Group Foundation website (<http://www.fundacaogrupoboticario.org.br/>) and selected applicants will be contacted via e-mail up to 30 days prior to the period starting.

THE INSTITUTION PROVIDES

- Daily transport fares (two-ways) for applicants living in Corumbá and Ladário.
- Training focused on environmental education monitoring and support.
- Life insurance during the period of participation in the program.

CERTIFICATE AND FINAL PROVISIONS

At the end of the volunteering period, the Pantanal Nature Station will issue a certificate with the period of work, the total hours worked, and the activities conducted. It is essential to acknowledge that volunteer work does not constitute employment and compensation bond, in accordance with Law 9608/1998.
